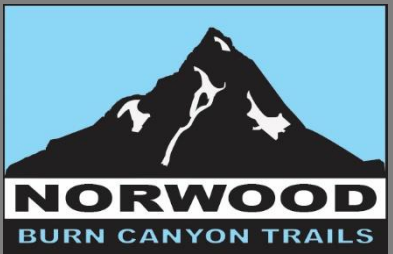


# BURN CANYON TRAILS PROJECT

## NOVEMBER 2016 PROGRESS REPORT



### COLORADO PARKS AND WILDLIFE GRANT

In 2016, Norwood Park and Recreation District was awarded a **\$200,000** grant from Colorado Parks and Wildlife! Funding was provided by the Federal Highway's Recreational Trails Program, and administered through the Colorado Parks and Wildlife Trails Program.



Project work includes 9 miles of non-motorized trail construction and one trailhead on CR W35. Trail construction completed by Bedrock Land Works and Southwest Conservation Corps (SCC).

### NEW TRAIL CONSTRUCTION

- 1. Bedrock Land Works - 2.1 miles
  - 2. SCC - 3.8 miles
- Total completed to date = 5.9 miles**

Bedrock Land Works completed all trail layout and design, large vegetation clearing for SCC, and supervision of SCC.

The two loops that originate from the proposed trailhead are now complete! These trails are open to hiking, biking, and equestrians. BLM has implemented seasonal wildlife closures to motorized and mechanized use from December 1-April 30. Please respect these closures!

### TRAILHEAD WORK

Foley and Associates has completed the trailhead survey. BLM has also completed the draft trailhead plans. Construction on the trailhead will likely begin in May 2017.
